

Conflict Minerals Statement

Dear customer,

Thank you very much for choosing wireless modules of SIMCom. For Conflict Minerals issue, SIMCom has already begun working with our suppliers to ensure that our customers will not experience any supply interruptions from activity.

SIMCom uses Tungsten, Tantalum, Tin and Gold in most of our semiconductor devices. Each of these metals has specific electrical properties which are necessary for the function of our products.

SIMCom does not purchase these metals directly from smelters or mines. We are working with our direct suppliers to understand their supply chain and determine the origin of these metals. Our suppliers have provided preliminary assurance that these metals are not sourced in the DRC, but these assurances have not been verified. We have not yet identified the smelters used by our direct suppliers of these metals.

We are certain that when the electronics industry approves a credible due diligence practice and regulations are finalized, more answers will be forthcoming. SIMCom is looking forward to working with our customers to prove these methods to be reliable.
